VETERANS BANNER SPONSORSHIP FORM 2026

The sponsor agrees to pay the St Marys Legion the sum of \$200 to sponsor a veteran's banner.

Once made, the banner will become the property of the sponsor. The banner will be hung on a downtown street during the Remembrance period – beginning sometime in October and ending just after November 11th. Once removed, the banner will be returned to the sponsor or stored at the Legion for no cost. Banners will be hung in subsequent years at no cost as long as the banner remains in presentable condition.

Due to space limitations, only one veteran will be displayed per banner.

The sponsor must provide a photo of the veteran, digitally or in hard copy, preferably in uniform. Hard copies will be scanned and returned.

The following information is required to create the banner – please ensure spelling is correct.

Veteran's Name – this could simply be a name, ie John Jones, or a name with rank, ie Sergeant John Jones

Veteran's Name: _____

Veteran's Branch of Service – options include Royal Canadian Navy, Canadian Army, Royal Canadian Air Force, Canadian Merchant Marine, or Royal Canadian Mounted Police. It could also include a squadron, regiment or ship, such as the Perth Regiment, 426 Squadron, or HMCS IROQUOIS. Wartime service can also be identified, such as WW II Royal Canadian Regiment
